Who We Are

Thrive is a UK-based not-for-profit organisation. Thrive is the Data Controller for personal data processed in connection with our activities.

Personal Data We Collect

We may collect names, contact details, information you provide to us, volunteering or participation information, and other data you choose to share. We only collect data necessary for our activities.

How We Use Your Data

We use personal data to deliver our activities, respond to enquiries, manage volunteers or participants, and meet legal and safeguarding obligations.

Lawful Basis

We process data based on consent, performance of a service, legal obligation, or legitimate interests as a not-for-profit organisation, where these do not override your rights.

Data Storage and Security

We take appropriate technical and organisational steps to keep data secure. Data is retained only for as long as necessary and then securely deleted or anonymised.

Sharing Data

We do not sell personal data. We share data only where necessary with trusted parties and in accordance with UK GDPR.

Your Rights

You have rights to access, correct, delete or restrict processing of your data, withdraw consent where applicable, and complain to the Information Commissioner's Office.
